The Jonas Salk Award is a lifetime achievement award of \$10,000 presented annually to a Canadian scientist, physician or researcher who has made a new and outstanding contribution in science or medicine to prevent, alleviate or eliminate a physical disability.

If you wish to nominate a scientist, physician or researcher, please complete the abbreviated form below. If the nominee is selected for the shortlist you may be asked for further information to support the nomination.

The Jonas Salk Award Committee accepts nominations each year until March 1.

Eligibility Criteria

Award nominees must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident residing in Canada.
- Have made a significant contribution to science or medicine.
- Research conducted must have resulted in a significant advancement in scientific knowledge, prevention, treatment or cure of a physically disabling condition.
- Research findings must have been published in refereed journals.
